




# If you are not getting responses

- Know your ideal client
- Find your specialty
- Continuously improve pitches
- Constantly update profile
- Send out lots of proposals



# Interview Process

# Red flags

- Client asks you to take project off platform
- Client sends you links that require you to register on other websites
- Client requests free work
- Client asks you to cash check or money orders
- Client asks you to accept shipments and forward packages elsewhere
- Errors, inconsistency, repetition, impatience

\*\*\*If you are unsure, google them!

#### Contracts

- If using a platform the terms of service are the contract
- Scope of work what is required, who is responsible, when expected
- Payment terms include due dates
- Required materials
- Intellectual Property
- Worker status
- Termination




### Time management

- Hourly work
  - If you realize it's taking longer, ask the client what the priority is
  - Would they rather have you complete part of the job for the agreed upon hours or extend the hours and total price
- For fixed rate projects, if it takes longer you make less per hour

# Schedule and Prioritize

- Create a routine
- Be realistic and don't overload yourself
- Plan ahead and set aside blocks of time to work on projects
- Break projects into smaller pieces and create mini goals and timelines
- Prioritize tasks and make lists
- Use your calendar to set reminders
- Stay motivated!



## Freelancer rights and responsibilities

#### You are entitled to

- Work where, when, and how you wish
- Contract with whoever you wish
- Subcontract to anyone you wish

#### You are not eligible for

- Social security
- Unemployment
- Minimum wage
- Overtime

#### Expenses

- Set aside 25-30%
- Save receipts
- Talk to a professional if you plan to make a significant amount
  - You may be responsible for selfemployment tax as well as income tax
  - You may be required to pay quarterly estimated taxes



# Physical Safety

- Be aware of your surroundings
- Trust your instincts
- In case of emergency, remove yourself from the situation and call the police
- Report inappropriate behavior, emergency incidents, or unreasonable or dangerous demands to customer service



# Keep your career goal in mind

- Set goals and break down steps to get there
- Leverage experience to obtain the position you want
- Make money on a flexible schedule but don't give up your goals





# Things to Consider

- Can you provide your own equipment?
- Can you manage your schedule?
- Can you handle unpredictable earnings?
- Can you work independently?
- Do you prefer flexibility?
- Do you have access to benefits?
