- A premature baby is about as tall as a 20 oz. bottle of water.

March of Dimes-History



- ▶ In 1921, Franklin D. Roosevelt, was paralyzed. At the age of 39, FDR became a victim of Infantile Paralysis due to Polio. During the years to come a fundraiser would be held in FDR's honor, on his birthday, January 30th.
- ▶ In 1938, a performer by the name of Eddie Cantor, promoted the fundraiser, call for the "March of Dimes"
- ▶ The first "March of Dimes" radio appeal occurred during the weeks preceding the Birthday Ball event of January 30th. The "March of Dimes" will enable all persons , even the children, to show our President that they are with him against Polio.
- ▶ Nearly everyone can send in a dime, or several dimes. However, it takes only ten dimes to make a dollar and if a million people send only one dime, the total will be \$100,000.00.

March of Dimes - Programs

- ▶ **Prenatal Education, support and care** – ensuring the best possible start for the parents- to –be and their baby, by providing access to care, online and in person education and support.
- ▶ **NICU initiatives** – Special training for NICU employees and supporting the families with support, while their baby is in the NICU unit. Some babies stay in the NICU for a couple of months. NICU support is the best way to involve families in the care of their baby.
- ▶ **Health equity initiatives** – We're also an active collaborator and partner directly working to advance programs, research and policies to ensure that every mom and baby is healthy regardless of wealth, race or geography. To end the healthy equity gap.
- ▶ **Research** - Supporting investments in medical, scientific and social science research that are vital to fight for the health of all moms and babies. It took seventeen years and more than \$25 million in research later, the polio vaccine was declared safe and highly effective. Newborn screening began in 1963 when Massachusetts first screened for PKU (phenylketonuria), using a test developed by March of Dimes.

March for Babies - is a charitable walking event sponsored by the **March of Dimes**. It began in **1970** as the first charitable walking event in the United States. The name was changed after the 2007. **March for Babies** is held yearly in 1,100 communities across the nation.

We can march together to do something about the serious health crisis moms and babies face. You can make an even bigger impact by joining a team or starting your own.
